The Stewardship and Finance Committee reported the budget is still a work in progress. It was reported some pledge cards have not been returned. There are still safety and security expenses that need to be addressed.

When the necessary tax papers and application have been completed, there will be an application for approval as an alternate in the nursery. Another college student has been contacted that may be interested in helping in the Nursery.

The Playground Committee reported mats have been recently placed under the swings and at the ends of the slides to cover the heavy traffic areas.

The Memorial Committee reported interest earned on the account at F & C Bank for October was \$.99 bringing the balance to \$5,456.24.

The Helping Hands Committee is working with an individual with past due bills in the amount of \$1,265.26. Another individual is receiving assistance with a physician's bill for \$781.00.

The Security Committee reported the trauma kits will be very helpful for those injured. The committee has begun to work on key fobs and access control. The group is planning to contact the Future Planning Committee about future security needs and expenses.


The church is needing volunteers in the kitchen. Training by the Johnson County Health Department is required annually. More information will be available soon.
