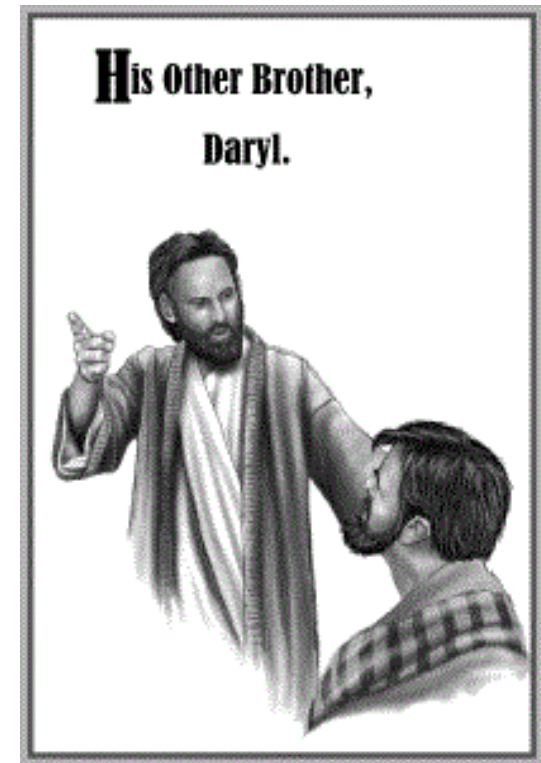

### **It's 'Souper Bowl' Time**

The Johnson County Food Center is asking for our support as they embark upon their 22nd year of providing warm soup for many that are hungry in our community. In Romans 12:13, we are told to "Share with God's people who need help."

Last year the Warrensburg community donated 48,000 cans of soup for the "Souper Bowl", and First Christian provided 12,447 of those cans of soup. We will hope to provide that much, or more, this year. If you want to contribute money, just indicate "Souper Bowl" on your check and we will shop for you and get the soup to the Food Center. A case of Chicken Noodle, Tomato, or Vegetable costs \$10.50, and a case of Cream of Chicken or Cream of Mushroom costs \$11.00. If you prefer to shop yourself, please leave your soup in the lobby of the Christian Life Center. The "Souper Bowl" campaign will end on February 5.
