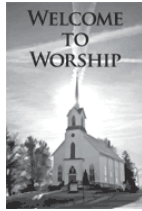

## It's 'Souper Bowl' Time

The Johnson County Food Center is asking for our help to stock The Food Center with soup for 2016. This is the 21<sup>st</sup> year for the 'Souper Bowl' campaign that feeds those who are hungry. Last year the community collected over 35,000 cans for soup, and the goal is to provide at least that much soup again this year.

First Christian provided 7,561 cans of soup for the 'Souper Bowl' event in 2015. We will hope to provide that much, or more, this year.

A contribution of \$10.00 will purchase 28 cans of chicken noodle, vegetable, or tomato soup. If you would like, we can shop for you. Just make your contribution to the church and mark it for 'Souper Bowl.'

If you prefer to shop yourself, The Food Center also likes to receive cream soups. Just bring your soup to the Christian Life Center, and we will deliver it on February 7.
