All Saints Day-November 5, 2017

All Saints Day grew out of the early church's practice of remembering the martyrs of the church. Special days to recognize Saints developed over time. By the late 300s, such a day was often held on the Sunday after Pentecost. By the mid-700s, All Saints Day became connected with November 1. Early leaders of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) concerned with "restoring the New testament Church" and with "Bible names for Bible things" would have found little justification for All Saints Day. Only in the past 30 years have Disciples found a place for All Saints Day in congregational life compelled by the opportunity to enhance the ministry of the church. Halloween and All Saints Day have a confused connection. Suffice it to say that the end of October was a special time in pre-Christian religious understanding. Halloween literally is The Evening before All Hallows Day or All Saints Day; the day on which all the Saints are hallowed. In some Christian traditions, a vigil of prayer is conducted on All Hollow's Eve to prepare for All Saints Day.

Here at First Christian we will celebrate by taking up an offering in memory of our beloved saints for the benefit of those less fortunate in our city and surrounding area. There is an insert in the newsletter last week and in this bulletin for you to be able to help out. The money collected will go to the Minister's Discretionary Fund and it is for those who come through our doors seeking assistance.
