HOMELESS SHELTER**
in Warrensburg, Feb. and March, 2019
We need your help!

Volunteers to staff the shelter:

- Shifts are 5-7 pm (intake), 7-11 pm (house monitor) and 11 pm-8am (overnight monitoring)
- Each shift must have a male and female volunteer
- Volunteers must be 18 or over, complete volunteer training, and submit to a background check

Monetary donations to pay for utilities:

- Estimated cost: \$800.00 per month. Any amount helps!
