

When Americans are asked to check a box indicating their religious affiliation, 28% now check 'none.' A new study finds that a group comprised of atheists, agnostic and those who say their religion is "nothing in particular" – is now the largest cohort in the U.S. For me, Jesus' answer to this question is a big part of my "why." We will study **Incarnation: Rediscovering the Significance of Christmas** by Adam Hamilton, pastor of the United Methodist Church of the Resurrection in Kansas City.
